

HOW DO I APPLY TO BE A DELEGATE?



Because Triennium is a delegated event, registration happens through Pittsburgh Presbytery. Here are the application steps and important dates...

1. Get an application from your Pastor, Youth Leader or at http://www.pghpresbytery.org/disciplemaking/coming_events.htm
2. Complete the application and send it to:

3. Have your Pastor AND either your Youth Director, Director of Christian Education or Clerk of Session complete a recommendation form and mail it directly to the above address.

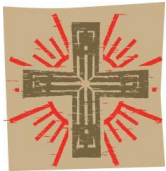

2010 Presbyterian Youth Triennium

WHAT IS IT?

The Triennium is a gathering of youth and leaders from the Presbyterian Church (USA) and the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, as well as delegates from around the world. It happens every 3 years.



WHO CAN GO?

Youth who are between 15 and 19 years of age by July 20, 2010 may apply to be a delegate from Pittsburgh Presbytery. There is also one adult leader for every ten youth.



HOW MANY PEOPLE WILL BE THERE?

Approximately 6000 youth and leaders will be there! Pittsburgh Presbytery will have a delegation of up to 30 youth. This event is NOT designed for entire youth groups to attend together. Rather, one or two from a church represent that youth group and bring home the "Triennium Experience."

WHERE ARE WE GOING AND HOW WILL WE GET THERE?

Triennium will be held at Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana (about 65 miles northwest of Indianapolis). Our Presbytery delegation will travel together by bus, leaving from and returning to Mt. Nebo Pointe Shopping Center.



WHAT WILL WE DO AT TRIENNIUM?

In 2010, participants will explore the theme of "For Such a Time as This," from Esther 4:14. The gift of Christ's love will be experienced through creative presentations, small group meetings, recreation, a spirituality center, worship, singing, meals, Bible study, ministry/vocational opportunities and special events. Delegates will meet and interact with youth and adults from all parts of the country and world... many will form close and lasting friendships!



WILL THERE BE ANY MEETINGS BEFORE WE GO?

Yes! The team of delegates from Pittsburgh will have a couple meetings, including a retreat for the youth to get to know each other. The retreat is tentatively scheduled for Friday, April 23 - Saturday, April 24, 2010.

WHAT WILL IT COST ME?

The total cost is \$525.00, which includes housing, meals, conference t-shirt, transportation and all registration fees. The cost of PYT is significant, but there are ways to raise the money. Money should not be a reason that someone doesn't go!
