



Nominate a Young Adult from Your Congregation to be Our Presbytery's Young Adult Advisory Delegate (YAAD)

The 225th General Assembly (GA) will be held in June/July of 2022. The Session of your church may nominate a young person to attend the General Assembly as a Young Adult Advisory Delegate (YAAD). The person whom you nominate should be at least 17 years old on June 20, 2022, and no older than 23 years on that same date.

There will be a different format for GA in 2022. It will be a hybrid meeting in Louisville. Committees will meet on a staggered schedule, four at a time, with time build in for travel days between June 20 and July 3, 2022. Online plenary sessions will be held 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Eastern time from July 5-9, 2022. Saturday, June 16-23, 2018.

The person who is nominated and elected as a Young Adult Advisory Delegate will be required to attend all sessions of the in-person committees that they are assigned, on their meeting days and the online plenary sessions. He or she will have voice and vote in whichever committee he or she is assigned to and will have voice, but no vote, on the floor of the General Assembly.

Pittsburgh Presbytery can send only one Young Adult Advisory Delegate to each General Assembly. The person nominated will be chosen following interviews in August/September of this year by the Standing Committee on Nominations. Your session is not limited to nominating one young person. You may nominate as many young people as you feel are qualified to serve the church in this important capacity. We will be choosing a delegate and an alternate.
