The Minister of Music should be a person of faith who recognizes the important role that music plays in the worship life of a community of faith. The Minister of Music will be responsible for providing music for all worship services of the church (each Sunday and special services throughout the year), as well as special occasions such as weddings and funerals. (An additional fee may be charged for special occasions.) The Minister of Music will be responsible for preparing and conducting an adult volunteer choir and those involved in the Praise Team, and should be able to recognize, develop and utilize the musical talents of the members of Mt. Hope.

The Minister of Music will work with the Pastor and the Worship and Music Committee of the Session in facilitating and carrying out the music ministry of the church. This will involve the selection of music for each service, suggesting and providing special music (soloists, musicians, programs, etc.) when appropriate or needed. In addition, the Minister of Music will be responsible for ensuring that all licenses are current and cover the music to be performed. If unable to be present for a time of worship, the Minister of Music shall, in consultation with the Worship and Music Committee, secure the needed personnel. Above all else, the Minister of Music shall strive to provide music that glorifies God, touches the spirits of the worshipers, and enriches the worship experience for everyone.

The Minister of Music must obtain Act 33 and Act 34 clearances so that the church is compliant with current regulations. The position Minister of Music is a part-time salaried position that will be reviewed annually. The Salary is competitive and is based on experience and skill set.
